2019 Parade Rules & Guidelines

Parade Date: Saturday, December 14 at 4:30pm
Rain out date: December 21
Theme: A Magical Christmas

Antique Car Parade: Cars will need to line up on the west end of Riverwind Shopping Center. Line up begins at 4:00 pm. Parade will start at 4:30pm. The parade route for antique cars will come down Scarborough Street, left on Old 49, turn on Brandon Avenue. Once you reach Industrial Drive, turn right and exit the parade from Cleary Road.

Main Parade: The main parade will begin at 4:30pm. The parade will start at Westside Park and end at Westside Park. Line up will begin at 3:00pm with all floats lined up by 4:00pm to be judged. JUDGING WILL TAKE PLACE AT 4:00PM , SO DON'T BE LATE. Also, all entries in the parade should go at a very slow pace for everyone to enjoy the parade!

Awards: Best use of Theme, Best Overall Float & Best Group Presentation

- The parade will be at dusk. We encourage lights on your floats, and float spotters walking along side.
- Children riding in trailers must be supervised by adults walking along side of trailer/float. Children are not allowed to stand .
- You are allowed to TOSS candy, bead necklaces and other happies that will not endanger spectators. Please no literature such as brochures, flyers, etc.... as these usually end up on the streets after the parade is over.
